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ENTRY GUIDELINES

- 1. A description of the unit is required when filing the application.
- 2. All units must be decorated and/or have working lights on the float to be considered for entry into the City of Woodlake Christmas Parade.
- 3. All units must in some way reflect either the theme of the parade (preferred) or the holiday season.
- 4. Absolutely <u>no Santa costumed characters allowed in the parade</u>. There will only be one Santa and that will be provided by The Home Grown Project.
- 5. All parade entries must be pre-registered.
- 6. Units that delay the parade are subject to removal.
- 7. No political campaign signs will be allowed.
- 8. Candy may be handed-out.
- 9. The parade committee reserves the right to limit or determine participation in the parade.
- 10. Units must maintain no more than 50 feet between each other and must keep moving. For everyone's safety, no units may stop to perform.
- 11. Units must adhere to their assigned entry number.
- 12. No units may solicit <u>any</u> donations of cash or goods from spectators.
