



Maintenance Worker I/II or Water-Sewer Operator I/II

The City of Woodlake is seeking one (1) candidate for a Maintenance Worker I/II or Water-Sewer Operator I/II position. Candidate experience will determine classification and pay scale.

Maintenance Worker I/II will perform a variety of skilled and semiskilled duties in the Public Works Department. Duties will include maintenance, landscaping and semi-skilled plumbing. May construct install and repair partitions, shelving, doors, windows, roofs and floors. Will perform grounds work. Will perform other maintenance, repair, and construction duties as assigned. (\$3,589-\$5,099 monthly plus excellent benefits).

Water-Sewer Operator I/II will perform a variety of skilled and semiskilled duties in the Public Works Department. Duties will include maintenance and operations of control equipment such as pumps, motors, valves, blowers, sludge collectors, heat exchangers, sludge thickeners and other related process equipment. Will also be tasked with duties of water and sewer line replacements and maintenance, repair, and construction duties as assigned. (\$4,338-\$5,792 monthly plus excellent benefits).

The position requires education equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade and a valid Driver's License. The Operator position requires a State Water Resources Control Board License.
